WarDogs Maul Opponents!

In the Roth Conference, the Kentucky WarDogs posted a remarkable league-best 23-5 record in Period 3 and opened up a sizeable 14-game lead over Fallsburg (12-16 in Period 3) in the Aaron Division! Richmond (18-10) closed in on Fallsburg and only trail them by 4 games. In the Mays Division, Joe DiMaggio (19-9) took over 1st place, now leading a resurgent Eureka Valley (18-10) by 2 games, as Zaca's (12-16) slipped to 7 games behind.

Over in the Studenmund Conference, the Mudville Bandits (16-12 in Period 3) played well, but lost some ground in the Mantle Division. Death Valley (19-9) closed to only 3 games behind, with both Fort Lauderdale (18-10) and Berne (16-12) 7 games back. In the Clemente Division, leader North Adams Bevers (13-15) stumbled and find themselves now only 2 games ahead of New York (16-12) and Boston (16-12). A fading Van Schaick (14-14) will soon be passed by a rising Troy squad (16-12).

The batting leader is still Fallsburg's Shohei Ohtani at .357, but is now only 1 point ahead of Kentucky's Ronald Acuna! Ohtani still leads in SLG (.759), OBP (.451), EXBH (56) and is 2nd to Acuna (89) in RC by 0.5 RC (88). Albany's "Player of the Period" Matt Olson is virtually tied with Ohtani with 88 RC! Olson is the new RBI (74) and HR (34) leader. The SB leader is still Acuna (41 SB, 16 CS).

The ERA leader is still North Adams's Gerrit Cole now at 2.15, followed by New York's Kyle Bradish (2.31). There are four tied with 9 victories, North Adams's Charlie Morton (9-2), Kentucky's Aaron Nola (9-3), Joe DiMaggio's Spencer Strider (9-3) and Berne's Merrill Kelly (9-4). The new Strikeout leader is Cole with 148 K. The Saves leader is still Zaca's Evan Phillips (21-for-24 in SVO, 28 GR, 1.01).
