**Marauders on a Rampage!**

In the **Roth Conference**, the **Fallsburg Marauders** put up a JPTML best **24-4** record in Period 3 and extended their lead in the **Aaron Division** to 9 games over **Tarpin Ridge** (17-11 in Period 3). In the **Mays Division**, **New Britain** (16-5) took back 1<sup>st</sup> place, as **Joe DiMaggio** (10-18) took a tumble and is now in 2<sup>nd</sup> place, 6½ games behind! **Eureka Valley** (19-9) and **Gotham City** (16-12) are still in the Wild Card battle.

Over in the **Studenmund Conference**, the **Carolina Cubs** posted a **Conference** best **20-8** Period 3 record and now has a 10-game lead in the **Mantle Division** over **Death Valley** (16-12 in Period 3) and 12 games over **California** (16-12). In the **Clemente Division**, **New York** (18-10) still has a slim 3-game lead over **Boston** (18-10) with **Albany** (19-9) gaining one game at 5 games off the pace. **North Adams** (10-18) had a rough Period and is now 13 games behind.

The new batting leader is **Fallsburg's Aaron Judge** at **.342**, followed by **Eureka Valley's Juan Soto** at **.333**. **Judge** still leads in OBP (.447), SLG (.761), EXBH (51) and RC (95), while 2<sup>nd</sup> to **Soto** in RBI (77 to 76) and HR (35 to 34). The new SB leader is **Gotham City's Elly De La Cruz** (33 SB, 12 CS).

The ERA leader is still **Death Valley's Zack Wheeler** at **1.56**. Still in 2<sup>nd</sup> is **New Britain's Paul Skenes** at **1.79**. There are still 8 qualified pitchers with an ERA under 2.50. **Skenes** remains the victories leaders at **15-3**, as well as the Strikeout leader with 148 K. The new Saves leader is **Tarpin Ridge's Robert Suarez** (27/29 SVO, 32 GR, 1.77).

He was followed by **Trent Thornton** (2 IP), **Grant Anderson** (2 IP), **Greg Weissert** (1 IP) and **Caleb Thieblar** (1 IP). The group of five did not allow any hits and only walked 2. Ironically, the losing pitcher, **Matthew Liberatore** was on the better end of a no-hitter last Period!
