

CHARLESTON SAILING ALONG

The Charleston Riverdogs continued to roll along during January play, maintaining SABA's best record and largest division lead. The Dogs rank high among league teams in both hitting and pitching. Their .273 batting average is tops in the league, their 570 runs scored is 74 more than the second place team, and they also have hit a league leading 172 homeruns. On the pitching side, the Charleston hurlers have the league's second best ERA, 3.86, second only to defending champion Summit.

During January, the Riverdogs had stellar offensive performances from Alex Rodriguez (.365, 4 HR, 17 RBI) and Barry Bonds (.289, 8 HR, 14 RBI). Division rival Mudville had the league's best January record, 12-4, thanks to the slugging of Magglio Ordonez (.410, 5 HR, 17 RBI), Shawn Green (.246, 6 HR, 21 RBI), and Bernie Williams (.333, 4 HR, 12 RBI). But even so, they still have the largest margin to make up of any second place team.

Evanston, at 11-5, and Oregon, at 10-6, moved up in their division races. The Express got a big performance from Paul Konerko, who hit .323 with 3 HR and 20 RBI. Tim Hudson went 3-0 on the mound with a 2.45 ERA. Oregon got Player of the Month winning production from Sammy Sosa, who hit .424 with 10 HR and 23 RBI. Both teams moved within a single game of their division leads. Nothing changed in the Cornhusker Division race, as the three top teams all had 8-8 months.
