## THREE DIVISIONS VIRTUALLY SEWN UP

As SABA enters the final month of the 2002 season, three of the four divisions are all but clinched. Although not mathematically won, Charleston in the Continental Division, Summit in the Cornhusker Division, and Walled Lake in the Great Lakes Division seem to be certain champions.

The only close race is in the Carolina Division where Oregon and Riverside are battling. The Ducks May schedule seems slightly tougher than Riverside's. Both teams face Red Hook and Mudville while the Redbirds draw Carmel and Houghton and Oregon plays Cleveland and Capitol Conference powerhouse Charleston. Both are likely playoff teams.

It was a bad month for Platte Valley and Mudville. Both had 5-11 April records, putting their wildcard status in jeopardy. A 10-6 month brought Galveston into the wildcard picture. The Barons played two of the top Continental Conference clubs – Charleston and Riverside (both home and away). They also got beat up by lowly Houghton. Platte Valley batters hit a miserable .205 for the month.

Meanwhile, the league's top two teams, Charleston and Summit, just kept rolling. They both had 12-4 April records. The Riverdogs' Barry Bonds and Alex Rodriguez had sizzling bats. Bonds hit .373 with 8 HR and 19 RBI. A-Rod hit .328 with 8 HR and 18 RBI. Starting pitchers Odalis Perez, Jarrod Washburn, and Mark Buehrle went a combined 8-0.

As usual, Summit relied heavily on the strong right arm of Randy Johnson, who went 3-0 with a 1.64 ERA and 2 shutouts. Brad Fullmer, .328 6 HR 12 RBI, led the Antelope hitters and was joined by Jacque Jones who also hit six home runs.
