# Black Sox Hunger To Avenge!

The defending Atmospheric Conference champs California Black Sox are determined to avenge their TML World Series loss last season, coming within 1 inning of winning the TML Championship! The Black Sox went 21-9 in June and opened up a 7 game lead over Toxic Waste and 8 games over Chesapeake in the Pertierra Division. Beverly (17-13) extended their Gatto lead to 8 games over New York and 9 games over Santa Ana. In the Robinson, Madison (16-14) now has a strong 10 game lead over Vanderlyle.

Over in the Oceanic Conference, the Kentucky WarDogs put up a league best 22-8 record in June, opening up a 9 game lead over Danny Way in the Ruth Division! Albany (17-13) gained a bit of ground in their Steinmetz lead, now 12 games ahead of Mudville and 15 games over 'Skayuna! In the Williams, one finds the closest race as Rocky Mountain (17-13) now leads Marco Island by only 1 game and Walla Walla by 3 games.

Albany's Matt Olson still leads in HR (27), EXBH (57), OBP (.445), SLG (.678) and RC (102). Kentucky's Paul Goldschmidt is the new RBI leader with 78. The SB leader is Toxic Waste's Ronald Acuna (48 SB, 14 CS).

The ERA lead is shared by Danny Way's Miles Mikolas and California's Wade Miley, both at 2.17. They are followed by Miley's teammates Justin Verlander (2.57) and Zack Wheeler (2.59). The victories leaders are Madison's Emmet Sheehan (12-3) and Homestead's Aaron Nola (12-4). The Strikeout leader is still Toxic Waste's Spencer Strider with 148 K, one ahead of Nola. The Saves leader is still Kentucky's David Bednar (25/29 SVO in 37 GR, 2.57 ERA).
