Vegas did it with superior pitching, posting a 2.47 ERA, 5 shutouts and 15 Saves! In the Williams, Rocky Mountain opened up 18-8 and they too have a 7-game lead over the pack! In the Ruth, Arkansas and Kentucky are tied at 19-7 and are already 9 games in front!

Over in the Atmospheric Conference, the races are <u>much</u> closer. The largest lead is just 2 games in the Pertierra Division, where Chesapeake (16-10) leads California (14-12). The victories leaders are **Vegas's Seth Lugo** and **Vanderlyle's Colin Rea**, both 5-0. The early Strikeout leader is **Madison's Logan Gilbert**, with 50 K. The early Saves leader is **Vegas's Joe Jimenez** (10/10 SVO in 13 GR, 1.10 ERA).
