Arkansas First to "Clinch!"

In the Oceanic Conference, the Arkansas Travelers posted a 17-9 record in September to virtually clinch the Ruth Division pennant. They lead Kentucky (15-11 in September) by 15 games with 16 to go! In the Steinmetz, 'Skayuna (17-9) made a move on leader Vegas (14-12) but still trails by 11 games. In the Williams, Marco Island (13-13) played .500 ball, but maintained their lead over Rocky Mountain at 4 games. Albany (12-14) still has a shot at a Wild Card. The remaining teams in the Conference are below .500.

Over in the Atmospheric Conference, the California Black Sox posted a league best 19-7 record in September and now have an 8-game lead in the Pertierra Division over Chesapeake (12-14 in September). In the Robinson, Glenmont (16-10) has a commanding 12-game lead over Vanderlyle (14-12). In the Gatto, Beverly (15-11) gained a game on leader Santa Ana (14-12) and now is only 2 games behind. New York (11-15) had a tough month, but are only 4 games off the pace. The Wild Card battle will be a hot one in October!

The batting leader is still Chesapeake's Luis Arraez at .343 now well ahead of Albany's Yordan Alvarez at .313. Santa Ana's "Player of the Month" Shohei Ohtani is still the HR and Runs leader with 57 HR and 128 Runs. Ohtani is the new leader in SLG (.662), RBI (117), EXBH (87) and RC (154)! Kentucky's Francisco Lindor is still the SB leader (50 SB, 3 CS).

The ERA leader is still 'Skayuna's Tanner Houck at 1.88, followed closely by Arkansas's Ronel Blanco (1.92) and California's Zack Wheeler (1.99). The victories leaders are Blanco (18-2) and Wheeler (18-6). The Strikeout leader is still Albany's Garrett Crochet with 227 K, one K ahead of Wheeler. The Saves leaders are Rocky Mountain's Mason Miller (37/38 SVO in 50 GR, 1.03) and Glenmont's Ryan Helsley (37/39 SVO in 54 GR, 1.01 ERA).
