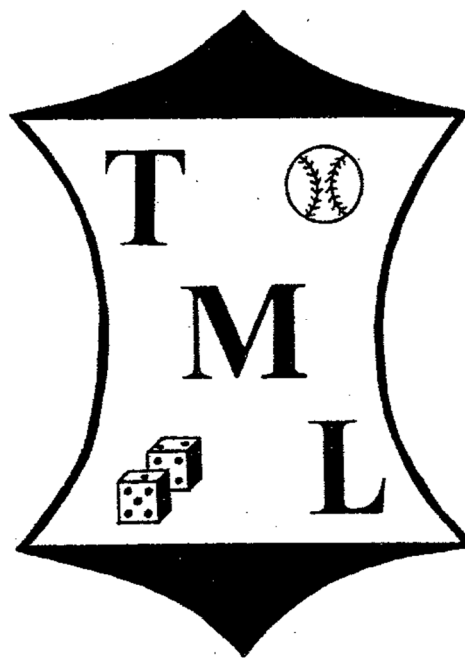

Oakdale's **Bill Terry** set a new **TML Record** for GW-RBI with **30**.

The longest winning streak of 17 games was done by **Oakdale** (7/12-7/30). The longest losing streak of 12 games was by both **Summer** (5/18-5/31) and **Duluth** (9/18-10/1). **Arkansas** won a **TML Record** 11th consecutive Conference Pennant!

11/3/1932, AV32-SF32, Wrigley Field

Pat Barry's Albany Avalanche won their record 14th TML Championship and first since 1949. For Pat, it is a record 13th TML Championship! They held off a relentless offense of Jeff Chapman's Sioux Falls Fighting Sioux in the TML World Series to win in 5 games! For Jeff, it was his 7th trip to the TML World Series and is still looking for his 1st Championship. Albany had advanced to the World Series by demolishing Oakdale's prized pitching staff in an unexpected quick 5-game series. Sioux Falls had upset Arkansas in 6 games to face Albany. Albany's Playoff MVP Lou Gehrig batted .368 (14/38), with 9 runs, 12 RBI, 4 2Bs, 3 HRs and 9 walks!

The Season Story

The 1932 Walla Walla Wombats finished with a 46–108 record, marking a difficult season filled with pitching struggles and defensive lapses. Despite the team's overall performance, several players delivered standout individual seasons that provided hope for the future. Right fielder Paul Waner was the offensive catalyst, batting .338 with 17 home runs, 119 runs, and 111 RBI. His .405 OBP and 336 total bases made him one of the league's most complete hitters. Second baseman Charlie Gehringer added strong support with a .296 average, 17 home runs, and 120 RBI, while also scoring 102 runs. Joe Sewell brought consistency at third base, batting .277 and driving in 114 runs. Rookie Harry Davis contributed 173 hits and 107 runs, and Jim Levey quietly added speed and defense, batting .271 with 16 steals. While the offense was competent, the pitching staff faltered badly, with a team ERA of 6.57 and 1,159 runs allowed. Gordon Rhodes was the workhorse, logging 191 innings and securing 11 wins despite a 4.29 ERA. Snipe Hansen showed glimpses of control with a 1.39 WHIP, but struggled to keep runs off the board. The rest of the rotation, including Pat Caraway (27 losses), Bob Cooney (20 losses) and Pete Daglia (20 losses) , were unable to provide consistency, combining for high ERAs and a lack of strikeout power. The Wombats were outscored by 433 runs, but their offensive nucleus gives the team something to build on. Significant improvements in pitching and bullpen depth will be essential for future success.
