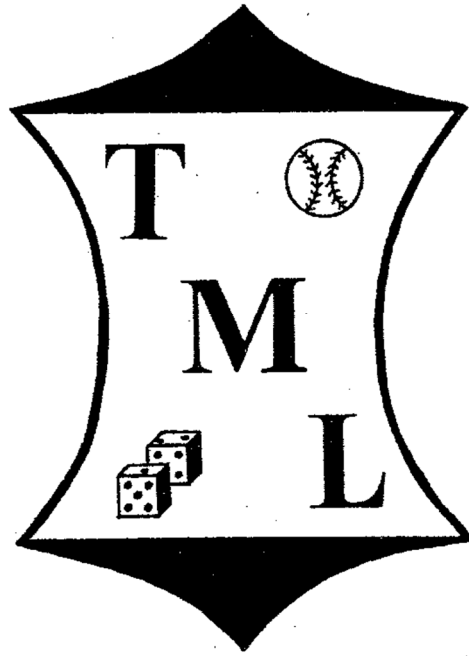

North Adams's Hank Greenberg set an all time **TML Record** for triples with 33 and led his team to Setting an all time **TML Team Record** for triples with 115. Sioux Falls set an all time TML Record For fewest strikeouts by their batters with only 324 Ks.

The longest winning streak of 12 games was done by Beverly (8/15-8/30) and the longest losing streak of 13 games was by Duluth (8/20-9/13).

11/5/1935, WW35-CH35, Shibe Park  
Eric Roger's Chestertown Blue Herons pulled a major upset in winning their 5<sup>th</sup> TML Championship and first since 1959. They entered the playoffs with the lowest regular season win total (83) of any TML Champion, breaking their own record in 1959 (86). Chestertown first dispatched their Conference Pennant winner Arkansas in 6 games and then beat Bryan Sakolsky's defending TML Champion Walla Walla Wombats, also in 6 games! Walla Walla had advanced to the TML World Series by getting past Beverly in 6 games. Chestertown's Playoff MVP was Buddy Myer, who batted .458 (22/48), with 12 walks for an OBP of .567. He scored 14 runs and only fanned 3 times in the 12 games!

$$A = H + BB + HBP - CS - GIDP$$

$$B = TB + [.26 \times (BB - IBB + HBP)]$$

$$C = .52 \times (SH + SF + SB)$$

$$D = AB + BB + HBP + SH + SF$$

**RC / 27 outs:** runs created per 27 outs; in other words, the number of runs a player would create if he were to bat in all nine positions in the batting order.

**QS (Quality Starts):** the number of starts in which a pitcher pitches six (6) innings or more and gives up three (3) runs or fewer.

**OAVG:** the batting percentage against each pitcher.
