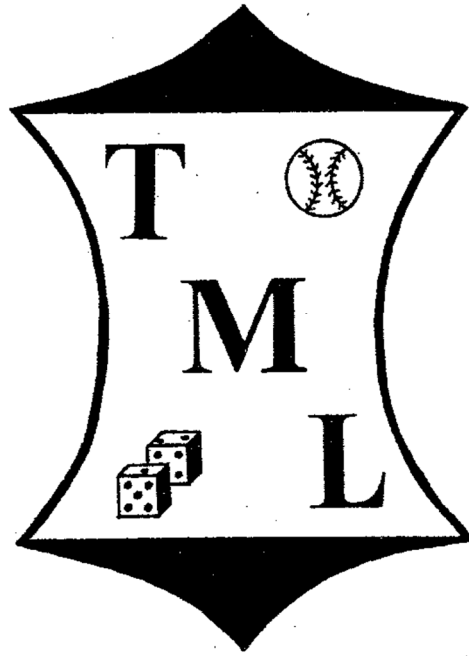

Sioux Falls set an all time **TML Record** for least batter Strikeouts with 345 K. Seattle set an all time **TML Record** for least Strikeouts by their pitchers with only 320 K.

The longest winning streak of 14 games was done by Arkansas (5/1-5/16) and the longest losing streak of 15 games was by Oakdale (8/18-9/5).

11/2/1937, WW36-AR36, Sportsman's Park (N)
 Turnabout is fair play, as Bryan Sakolsky's Walla Walla Wombats swept Willie Jelks's Arkansas Travelers in a reversal of 1937. It is the 4th TML Championship for the Walla Walla franchise, but the 10th for Manager Sakolsky! Arkansas may be the favorite in 1935 being on their odd-year run, having won TML Titles in 1937, 1939 and 1941. Arkansas easily dispatched Sioux Falls in 5 games to advance to the World Series, where as Walla Walla swept Beverly once again, to set up the 3rd straight World Series match-up! Walla Walla's co-playoff MVPs were Paul Waner who hit .517 (15/29), with 7 RBI and 10 BB, along with Lefty Grove who was 3-0 with a 1.08 ERA. The Walla Walla team was 8-0 with a 1.88 ERA for the entire playoffs!

The Highlanders closed out the DiMaggio era with yet another mediocre season, this time with 78 up, 76 down. Joe D. did just fine in his last tour of duty in the Bronx, hitting .321 with 32 HRs and 157 RBI. Luke Appling posted a .371 BA, and Red Rolfe came through with a .330 BA and 116 RBI. The rest of the offense was "meh." There were some surprises in the pitching staff, with Johnny Marcum posting a 3.05 ERA in his 23 starts, winning 14 games; Monte Pearson won just as many games...unfortunately, he also lost just as many. Bill Dietrich overperformed, mostly in a relief role, posting a 2.52 ERA.

There just weren't many other highlights in the Bronx for 1936. Now, with only 18 survivors left to man the Highlands in 1935 (going into the draft), there's no telling just how things will go down the road...now that "Joltin' Joe has left and gone away."

The Wombats capped off a strong season including winning the 1936 World Series, while leading the league in ERA and coming in second in offense. But for sure this team was about pitching. The starting rotation featured FOUR 20-game winners in Carl Hubbell (25), Lefty Grove (24) and Harry Kelley and Dizzy Dean (both 20). The little used bullpen was stellar with Mace Brown (1.20) and Frank Gabler (3.30) sporting solid ERAs and combining for 11 wins and 7 saves. The offense had some stellar performances Paul Waner slashed .362/.481/.526 with 76 extra base hits and scored 171 runs. Charlie Gehringer slashed .343/.488/.540 with 89 extra base hits and 147 RBI and 127 runs scored. Three other players: Hal Trosky (165 RBI 123 runs), Odell Hale (135 RBI, 131 runs) and Bob Johnson (120 RBI, 137 runs) topped triple digits in runs and RBIs. Trosky led the team with 34 homers.
