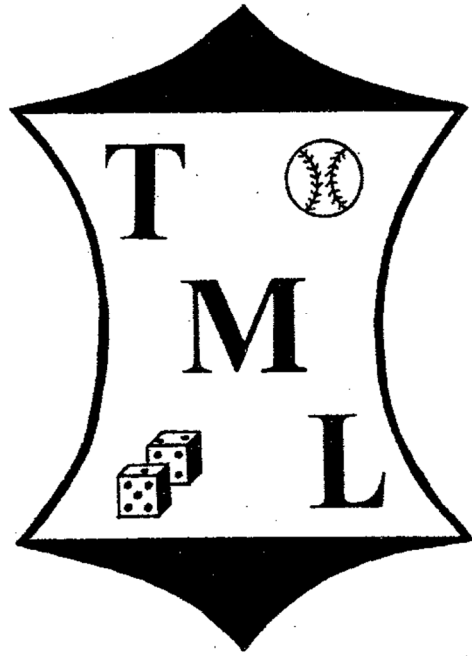

Bryan Sakolsky's Walla Walla Wombats cruised their way through the playoffs to dethrone Willie Jelks's Arkansas Travelers in a surprising 4-game sweep! While it is only the 2 <sup>nd</sup> TML Championship for the Walla Walla franchise (the first being 1962), it is Bryan's 8 <sup>th</sup> Managerial TML Championship! Walla Walla reached the TML World Series by sweeping the Beverly Hillbillies, while Arkansas got past the Bloomington Burning Bunyans in a quick 5 games! Playoff MVP Debs Garms hit .350 (14/40), with 9 runs and 11 RBI!
