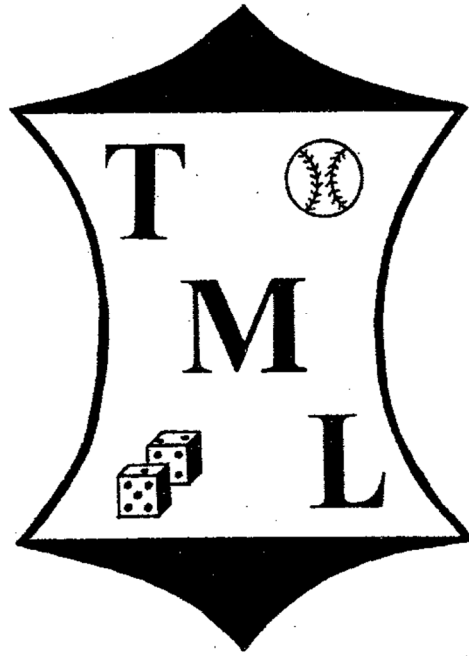

Ted Williams set a regular season TML Record for OBP (.554) and batted .411 for the 2nd time! Arkansas set a new team TML Record for most triples in a season (95).

The longest winning streak of 11 games was done by both Bloomington (6/19-7/3) and Bronx (8/19-9/1). The longest losing streak of 18 games was by Albany (8/8-9/7).

11/2/1941, AR41-BV41, Briggs Stadium

Willie Jelks and his Arkansas Travelers breezed through the playoffs to win the 1941 TML Championship! For both Mgr. Jelks and Arkansas it is their 3rd TML Championship and first since 1969. Arkansas reached the TML World Series by gliding past Bloomington in 5 games before sweeping Beverly in the Series. Beverly coasted past Seattle, but ran into a buzz saw in the Series! Arkansas Playoff MVP Whit Wyatt bested the Aces of the opponents in his four starts, including twice in the World Series against "Pitcher of the Year" Bob Feller.

So, Bloomington rather than stumbling (17-25 in Block 3) more accurately face-planted into a floor covered with cream pies, but somehow didn't manage to fall through the floor, securing a playoff berth despite a worse record than the past two years. Elbie Fletcher and Lonny Frey led the offense, while Elmer Riddle led the league in ERA and Charlie Wagner was a strong number 2. Kirby Higbe was more representative of team fortunes, losing his last 8 decisions. This still led to a stunningly close series with Arkansas with 7 lead changes and a tie in the 4-1 Travelers win. Super-PH Alex Kampouris drove in 6 runs with 2 hits in 4 attempts. This season also marks a farewell to Ken Keltner, a key piece in the 40's whose 1948 season was magical (155 runs created).
