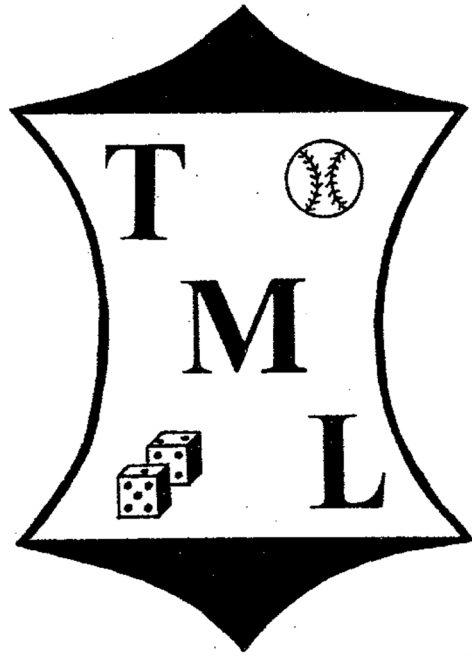

Mike Landin's Oakdale Ravagers won their 11 th TML Championship in defeating Jeff Chapman's Sioux Falls Fighting Sioux in 7 games! For Mike, it is his 10 th TML Championship, one short of the TML Record. Both teams had cruised into the TML World Series, Oakdale by defeating Duluth in 5 games and Sioux Falls by sweeping Sonoma. In the World Series, the team that scored first won each of the 7 games. The Series MVP was Oakdale's Eddie Lopat (2-0, 0.50, 2 CG, 1 Sho, 18 IP), including the Game 7 win!

The Season Story

A bitter sweet playoff (sweep) ended the Crushers' hard fought 1944 campaign, one of this franchise's most satisfying TML seasons. The one-game margin behind the Sioux Falls Fightin' Sioux was similar to the 1946 finish when the Crushers trailed the North Adams Bevers by just one game. After waiting nearly two weeks to play the home playoff games vs. Sioux Falls, Sonoma fell victim to Friday the 13th bad luck and dropped both home games which ended the season with a dissatisfying sweep. First baseman Frank McCormick was the offense leader with season totals of .336/.393/.548, 41 doubles, 5 triples, and 25 home runs. McCormick had 135 RBI. Pitching honors went the Preacher Roe (21-6, 2.64 ERA) which marked him as the first 20 game winner for the franchise in 11 seasons. The Crushers have reached the .500 mark over the past 11 seasons at 847-847 and will be seeking to make the playoffs in a tight 1943 Atmospheric division race.
