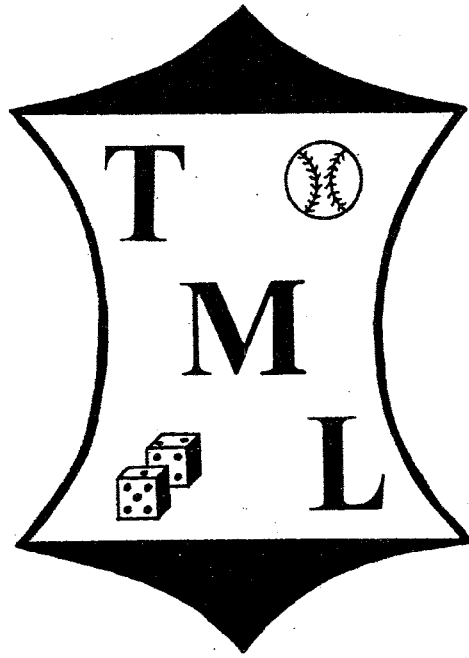

Chestertown set a new **TML Record** for most triples (90). Duluth's pitching staff set **TML Records** For most CG (115), fewest GR (54) and tied the **TML Record** for fewest Blown Saves (2).

11/5/1946, NA46-MO46, Ebbets Field  
 Mike Ameen's North Adams Bevers won their first ever franchise TML Championship in defeating Bill Graham's Moosen Squirrel in 6 games! North Adams had advanced to the World Series by edging past Sonoma in hard fought 7 games. Moosen's first ever trip to the World Series was made possible by taking out Duluth in a surprising 5 games! Playoff MVP for the Bevers was Dixie Walker who batted .411 (23/56), with 4 walks, 13 runs scored and 11 RBI in the 13 games.

Not to be overlooked was the amazing bench of Dale Mitchell (obtained in pre-season while in bed late at night via text!) and Les Moss. Leon Culberson and Thurman Tucker made for a potent platoon. Pitching wise, 20-game winner Eddie Lopat emerged as the “Ace”, and was supported by Ewell Blackwell, Ed Wright and Mickey Harris. After 20 seasons, the Ravagers give a “fond farewell” to long time “Ace” **Warren Spahn** who put up a part-time 12-4, 2.20 final season. Spahn departs with 337 career victories (2<sup>nd</sup> all time to another franchise pitcher Greg Maddux) and remains the all time TML career leader, by far, in CG (454). Spahn also finishes #1 in QS (373), #3 in Shutouts (56) and #5 in IP (5,154).
