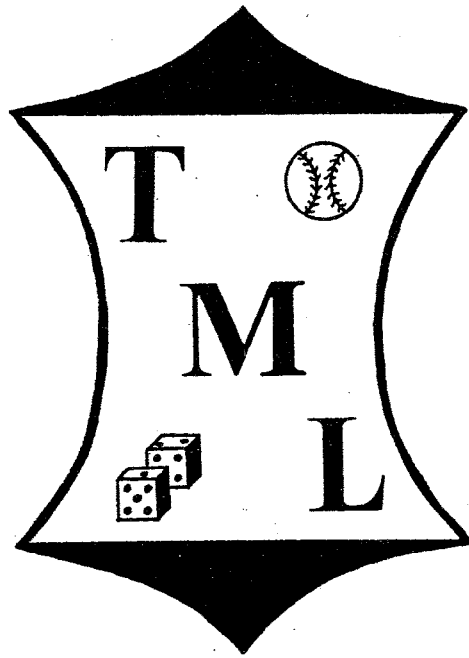

The longest winning streak of 13 games was done by both Albany (5/10-5/25) and Duluth (8/8-8/24). The longest losing streak of 13 games was by Arkansas (4/13-4/27).

Albany set a new TML Record for most walks by their batters (867) and Arkansas set a new TML Record for fewest strikeouts by their pitching staff (380).

The league AVG of .290 broke the previous league record high (.282 in 1953) by 8 points, with a TML Record three teams scoring in excess of 1000 runs! The league ERA of 5.24 was nearly a quarter of a run higher than the previous league record high (5.03 in 2000).

11/2/1949, SF50-AV50, Briggs Stadium  
 Pat Barry's Albany Avalanche wrapped up their Record 12<sup>th</sup> TML Championship and a league-leading 11<sup>th</sup> TML Championship for Pat! It also marked their 7<sup>th</sup> TML Championship in the past 10 seasons! Albany rallied from a 3-1 deficit in the Oceanic Conference Final against Walla Walla to win in 7 games and then rolled over Sioux Falls in their World Series sweep. Jeff Chapman's Sioux Falls Fighting Sioux edged past Chestertown in 6 games before getting buried by the Avalanche! Playoff MVP Mel Parnell tossed 3 CG, with 2 shutouts, posting a 0.67 ERA. Duke Snider hit .367, with 4 HR, 12 R & 15 RBI.
