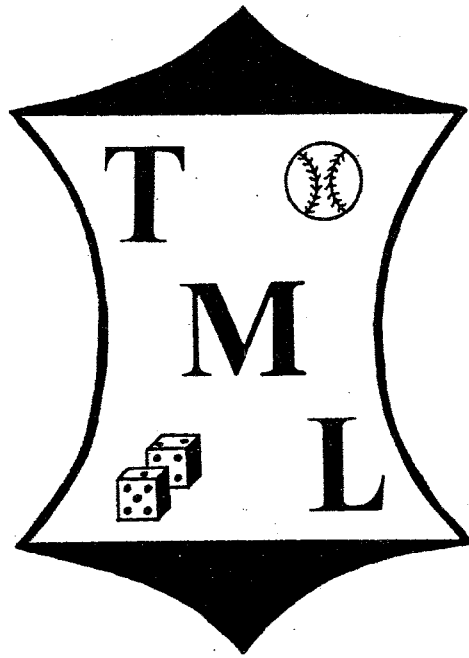

Summer had the longest winning streak of 13 games (5/9-5/24). The longest losing streak of 14 games was shared between Duluth (5/9-6/3) and Moosen (7/12-8/4).

Cheticamp set a new TML Record for highest team AVG at .318. Walla Walla set a new TML Record for fewest strikeouts by a pitching staff with 446 Ks. Individually, Bill Koski set a new TML Record for most Walks allowed with 257 BB.

11/5/1951, AV51-SM51, Ebbets Field  
 Pat Barry's Albany Avalanche returned to the TML World Series for the 7<sup>th</sup> time in thee past 8 seasons and defeated Ken Fusci's Summer Cyclones in 6 games. It was a record-setting 11<sup>th</sup> franchise Championship for Albany and for Pat, a record-setting 10<sup>th</sup> Managerial Championship. Albany had reachd the World Series by defeating the defending TML Champs Beverly in 6 games. Summer got to the World Series by outlasting Cheticamp in 7 games. Playoff MVP Ted Williams was outstanding, going 21/46 (.457), with 8 R, 9 RBI, 3 HR and 11 BB. Luke Easter (.517, 15/29, 6 EXBH, 8 RBI) was an additional offensive force in the Conference Final.

By overall statistics, the Burning Bunyans should have given off the same odor as last year, finishing 13th in batting average, 11th in OPS, and scoring a mere 35 runs more than given up. Instead, Bloomington took advantage of that pitching (second in runs allowed) and clutch performance to make a strong run at the playoffs. In close games and reversals, Bloomington was amazing, rallying 14 times in the last 2 innings, while only blowing 3 leads. Bloomington was a ridiculous 17-5 in extra innings and 27-14 in 1-run games (second to Walla Walla). The stars of the team were the pitchers, as Early Wynn (17-10, 3.05, 12 CG, 4 shutouts in 247.2 innings) was the ace with strong performances by Ned Garver (16-12, 3.49) and Tom Poholsky (9-11, 3.24) not always rewarded by the weak offense. All three pitchers had WHIP under 1.30. Then, a strong bullpen, led by likely Fireman of the Year Ted Wilks (52 app, 1.11 WHIP, .208 opposing batting average, 30-36 in saves, 8 relief wins), helped the clutch statistics. Surprisingly, Bill Wight and Chuck Stobbs were effective in set up roles. The offense was frequently offensive, but Gene Woodling had another above average year. And, there were key pinch-hit appearances by Bill Serena, Danny Litwhiler, and Johnny Pramesa. The key late-inning performances allowed BY to finish Block 3 27-14. Since all of SABRmetrics has proven that "clutch performance" is really sheer luck, Bloomington ended up dropping from third to 4th place in that last block. So, I can count on losing 17 out of 14 extra inning games in 1950.
