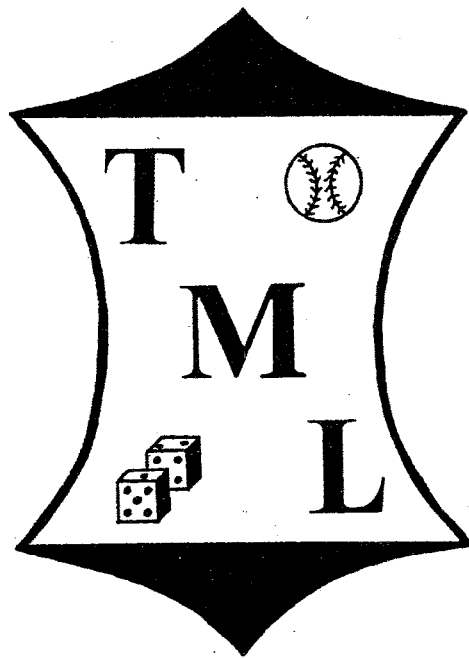

Cheticamp set a new TML Record for fewest strikeouts (375) by their batters, set in 1953.

11/5/1952, AR52-BV52, Briggs Stadium  
 Mike Dickinson's Beverly Hillbillies won their first Reto TML Championship by beating Willie Jelks powerhouse Arkansas Travelers in 6 games. Beverly had reached the TML World Series by getting past the 3-time defending TML Champs Albany in 7 games. Arkansas went the distance to defeat a peaky Cheticamp team to make it to the World Series for the 2<sup>nd</sup> consecutive season. Playoff MVP Robin Roberts was spectacular, going 3-1 with a 1.85 ERA in his 5 GS.
