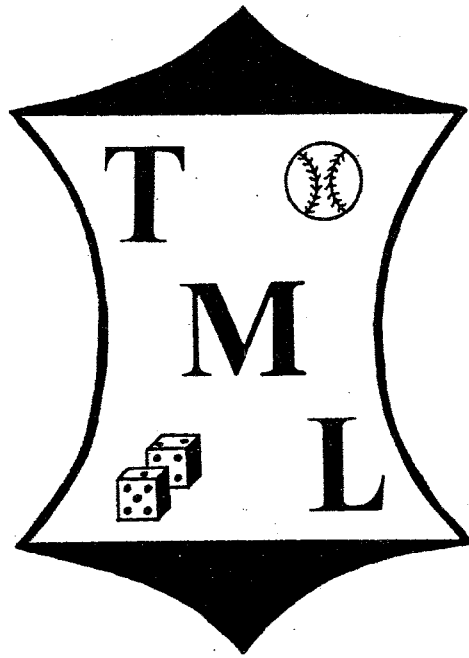

The longest winning streak was a **TML Record 30 games** by Albany (6/1-7/7). The streak was ended by last place Coachella Valley. The longest losing streak was 18 games by Summer (9/25-10/15).

Duke Snider was Albany's 4th consecutive "Player of the Year," joining Bob Rush as "Pitcher of the Year" and Clem Labine as "Fireman of the Year" as major contributors to Albany's amazing season.

Ted Williams remains the TML Career Leader in AVG (.360), SLG (.682), OBP (.484) and RC/27 (12.8). Teammate Mickey Mantle is now #2 in three categories (SLG .639, OBP .451, RC/27 11.3). Richie Ashburn (.332) has moved into 2nd in batting. Hank Aaron remains in 2nd place in HRs, only 20 HRs behind Career HR leader Barry Bonds (743 HR), with one more season to go! Aaron is the new Career GW-RBI (315) leader and remains the Career RBI (2468) and TB (6574) leader. Aaron is still in 2nd place in Career EXBH (1398). Sandy Koufax remains #2 in Career ERA (2.77) behind Mariano Rivera (2.68). Whitey Ford (2.82) is in 3rd place in ERA.

Pat Barry's powerhouse Albany Avalanche reached the TML World Series for the 4th consecutive season and captured the TML Retro Championship! It was their record tying 8th franchise Championship and for Pat, a record-tying 7th Managerial Championship. The Avalanche rolled over Beverly in 5 games and then swept North Adams. Mike Ameen's North Adams Bevers had reached the TML World Series by defeating Arkansas in 5 games. Playoff MVP Mickey Mantle played in every game, hit .313, with 10 Runs scored, 5 EXBH and an OPS of 1.030.

The Season Story

In 1955, Albany put together its best season ever, winning 124 games and then taking 8 of 9 playoff games from tough Beverly and North Adams. The offense put up 1098 runs. Duke Snider hit 56 homers, scored 160 runs and drove in 201 to pace the offense. Mickey Mantle had 52 homers, scoring 183 times and knocking in 156. Al Smith, back in a starting role after a few season's hiatus, hit .314, scored 156 times and knocked in 108. The team as a whole, including pitchers hit .303 with nearly .400 on base and .500 slugging. In a band box, the Albany pitching allowed only 570 runs, narrowly missing leading the league in fewest runs allowed. The staff was led by Bob Rush (24-4 2.34ERA and Billy Hoelt (22-4 2.70 ERA) who each merited Pitcher of the Year consideration. Clem Labine (8-6 29 Sv 2.81 ERA) anchored an effective bullpen. The team has reached its peak and can only go down, but hopefully the brakes can be applied enough to keep the team in the playoff mix for a few more years.
