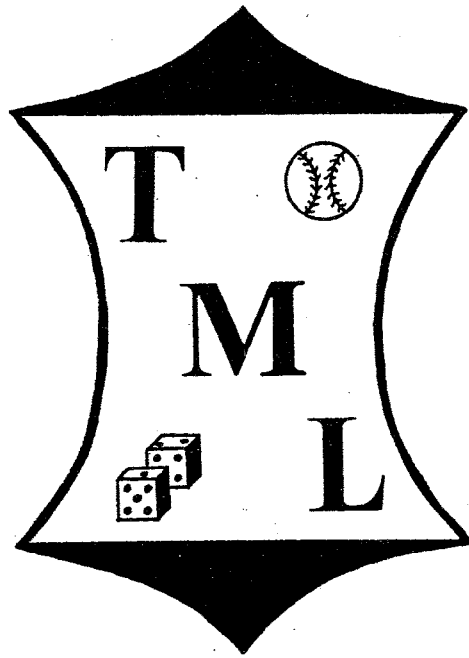

The longest winning streak was 10 games by Sumner (4/25-5/6), Albany (5/7-5/18), Jupiter (6/18-7/1), Coachella Valley (9/21-10/1) and Sanford (10/5-10/16). The longest losing streak was 15 games by Moosen (4/21-5/8) as part of a 1-24 skid.

Pete Runnels is the new TML Career Leader in AVG at .330, 3 points ahead of Tony Gwynn. Mickey Mantle remains the Career Leader in SLG (.602), OBP (.444) and RC/27 (10.3). Hank Aaron has moved into 3rd place in RBI (1933), only 81 behind Rafael Palmeiro. Frank Robinson and Aaron are 1-2 in GW-RBI, 246 and 244, respectively. Harmon Killebrew became the 6th member of the "600 HR Club," now tied with Alex Rodriguez for 4th with 609 HRs. Jim Bunning is the new Complete Games Pitching Career Leader with 231 CG.

Eric Rogers made it 4-for-4 in TML World Series appearances, as the Cheticamp Micmacs defeated Mike Landin's Coachella Valley Earthquakes in a thrilling 7-game series! The Quakes held a 3 games to 1 lead, before the Micmacs beat 28-game winner Jim Bunning (who did not win a playoff game) in G-5, Whitey Ford in G-6 and then Jack Sanford bested Warren Spahn (who was 5-0 in the playoffs at that point) in G-7 to capture the TML Championship. Playoff MVP Sanford only went 1-0 in his 5 playoff starts, but posted a sparkling 0.93 ERA over 38.2 IP, keeping his team in position to win! The Micmacs had disposed of Conference Champ Jupiter in 5 games to reach the TML World Series and Coachella Valley had survived a hard fought 7-game series against Conference Champ Albany.
