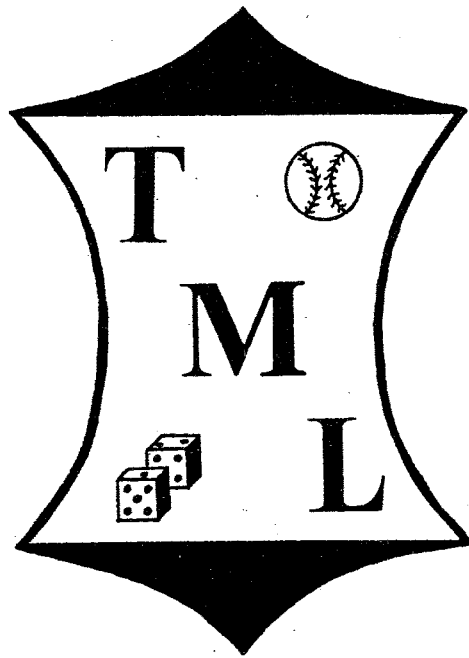

 Last day of season, saw Spahn excel at the plate *and* toss a CG 5-hitter to go 12-0 in Period 3.

The longest winning streak was 22 by Bloomington from 6/30-7/23. The longest losing streak was 23 by Arkansas from 7/3-7/28. Coachella Valley ended the season with 13 W in a row, having won 24 of their final 25 games, setting a TML Record road winning pct. of .813.

TML regular season records were broken by Harmon Killebrew (221 RBI) and teammate Norm Cash (175 R). Johnny Antonelli tied the TML Record for losses (32). Rensselaer set a new TML team regular season record for walks drawn (797).

Sandy Koufax won his unprecedented 6th consecutive "Pitcher of the Year" award and remains the TML Career ERA leader (1.92), three-quarters of a run lower than Mariano Rivera.

Mickey Mantle won a TML record-tying third "Player of the Year" award!

Carl Yastrzemski ends his career 2nd in Hits (3428), 3rd in Runs (2037) and 3rd in RC (2168).

10/20/1961, RS61-EQ61, County Stadium
 Mike Landin led his Coachella Valley Earthquakes to their 7th franchise TML Championship and his 6th title. Coachella rode their four 20-game winners past Sanford in a tight 6-game series and shut down the power-laden Rensselaer offense in a quick 5 games in the TML World Series. Rensselaer got to the World Series by out-slugging a persistent Perth squad.

The Season Story

After opening up the season 14-18 at home, it looked like another frustrating season ahead. Then, there was an unexpected 8-0 sweep of division rival Sanford. From that point on, the Quakes put it together, winning the tough Oceanic Conference Pennant, tying their franchise record with 113 wins and setting a new TML road WPCT of .813. This team's success was its exceptional starting pitching, led by their quartet of 20-game winners, Whitey Ford (25-10), Jim Bunning (24-9), Stan Williams (23-8) and Warren Spahn (23-10). Luis Arroyo (1.36, 11 SV) and newly acquired Tom Morgan (1.75, 20 SV) anchored the bullpen when needed. The team was no slacker on offense either, led by the power bat of Jim Gentile (.329, 54 HR, 145 R, 157 RBI, 175 RC). In most seasons, Gentile might have been "Player of the Year." Al Kaline (.326, 214 H, 55 2B, 150 R, 130 RC) had another super season and newcomer Rocky Colavito (41 HR, 157 RBI, 119 RC) "protected" Gentile in the lineup.
