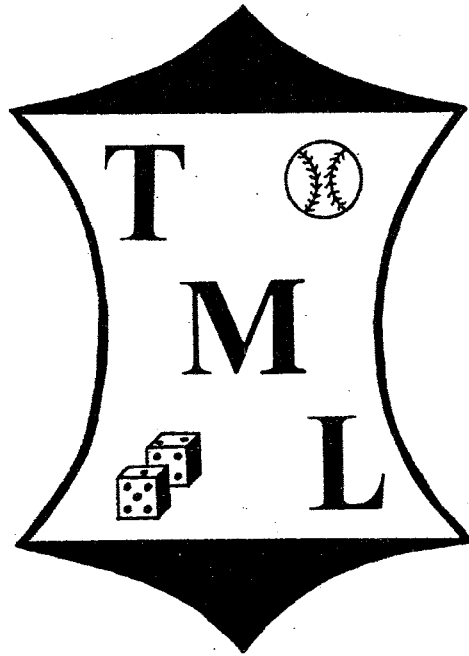

Albany's Matty Alou set a new all time TML Record for at bats with 748.

Coachella Valley shattered the all time TML Record for fewest fielding errors (24) in a season, but also set dubious single season team batting records, such as lowest AVG (.210), least hits (1133), least SB (5) and most times shutout (26), as well as team single season pitching records for most hits allowed (1938) and least strikeouts (541).

The longest winning streak was 14 put up by Sanford from 8/27-9/21. Albany won 21 of 22 from 7/16-8/20. The longest losing streak of 19 games was done by Moosen from 8/9-9/18 and were only 2-28 through 9/28. Coachella Valley went 2-29 from 7/1-8/5.

11/9/1969, SB69-AR69, Wrigley Field  
 Willie Jelks and his Arkansas Travelers won their second TML Championship by defeating Jim Pertierra's Sanford Browns in a tight 7 games in the TML World Series, after getting past the defending TML Champs in Eric Rogers' Cheticamp Micmacs in 7. Sanford had reached the TML World Series after winning yet another 7-game series against Albany. Post season leaders for Arkansas were Frank Howard (15 RBI), Harmon Killebrew (12 RBI) and Glenn Beckert (.396 and a steal of home in the 2-1 G-7 World Series victory). Sanford's Al Kaline had 16 RBI.
