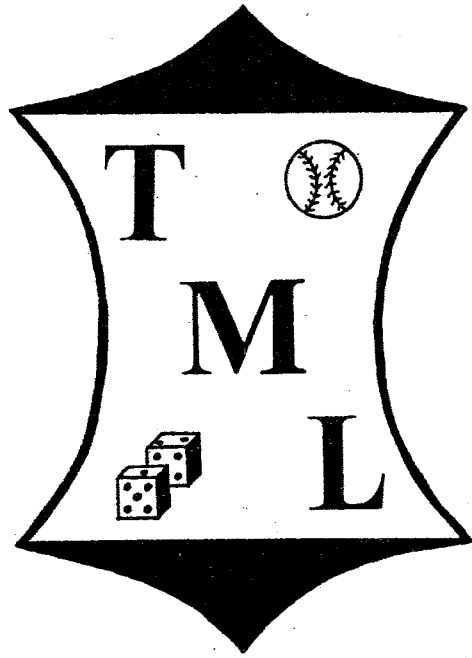

 Beverly's Ed Stroud ended Blyleven's no-hit bid with a 1-out single in the top of the 9th!

The longest winning streak was 12 put up by Tennessee from 5/29-6/11. The longest losing Streak of 11 games was done by Walla Walla from 5/24-6/5 and then by Hackensack from 6/7-6/19. Defending TML Champ Sanford won 12 of their final 14 games.

Pasadena's Carl Yastrsemski set a new all time TML Record for runs scored with 173. As a team, Walla Walla tied their own TML Record for homeruns allowed (287).

Coachella Valley's Bert Blyleven ended his TML career with 332 W (2nd overall), 228 CG (1st), 224 QS (1st), 51 Shutouts (tied 4th), 4740 IP (5th) and 3602 K (5th). Sioux Falls' Nolan Ryan is the career leader in strikeouts (5337), walks (2861) and GS (725) ... and, more to come.

11/8/1970, CH70-SB70, Dodger Stadium
 Eric Rogers' Cheticamp Micmacs dethroned the defending TML Champs, Jim Pertierra's Sanford Browns, coming from behind in a thrilling 7-game World Series! For Cheticamp, it is their 3rd TML Championship in the past 5 seasons! Tom Seaver was 4-0, 1.82 in 5 GS, while Bobby Murcer blasted 6 HR, good for 15 RBI in the post season. Cheticamp glided by power-hitting Pasadena, with stellar pitching, holding the B-Buttons to only 11 runs in the 5 games. Sanford had a tougher time with Albany, but prevailed on the strength of their pitching. In what was expected to be a pitching-dominated World Series, turned into an offensive battle. The lowest scoring game was G-7, won by Cheticamp, 5-1, behind their Ace Seaver.

This was supposed to be a final “competitive” season for the Quakes, but the inability to win home games (like the rest of the division) and play consistent ball (especially against the weak teams), cost them any chance at seriously challenging Sanford and Beverly. The standout offensive (and mental) leader was Rusty “Le Grande Orange” Staub who put up big numbers, but lacked consistent support around him. Merv Rettenmund and Jay Johnstone were terrific in their part-time roles. The pitching staff was also inconsistent, sometimes pitching great and then ... terrible. The one exception was 19-year old Bert Blyleven (12-9, 2.84), who only had 3 poor starts. Sadly, this is the end of a remarkable TML career for Blyleven who ends up with 332 W (2nd overall), 228 CG (1st), 224 QS (1st), 51 Sho (tied 4th), 4740 IP (5th) and 3602 K (5th). Closer Stan Williams suffered from “*DMB Disease*” (3.56 TML vs. 1.99 MLB) as he had trouble putting together consecutive solid outings, despite pitching in a “Pitchers’ Park” at home. In addition to Blyleven, management thanks the following departing long-time star players: Cesar Cedeno, George Foster and Bob Watson. With a roster of only 17 heading into the Player Draft, the outlook for 1969 is ~~not good- very bad- horri-~~ ... depressing.

The Season Story

Walla Walla surprised in 1971 and sunk back in 1970. Offense was not a problem as the Wombats scored 916 runs behind a huge year from MVP candidate Bobby Bonds (.351, 43 homers, 220 hits, 135 RBI, 1.049 OPS, 51 steals (becoming the first 40/40 man in TMLAM history. Sal Bando, Ron Fairly, Roy Foster and Ken Henderson all had over 90 runs created for the season as the Wombats had a killer lineup. And if they got to face the Wombat pitching staff, it would have been even better. Jim Merritt stood alone as everyone else got pasted. The automanager loved Gerry Arrigo, but it was alone.
