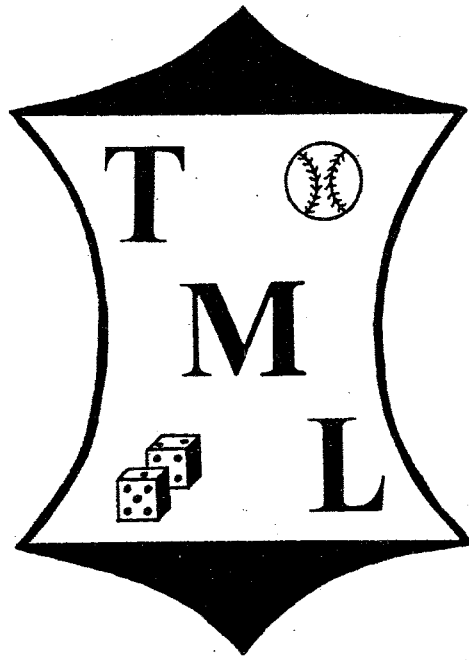

Beverly ended their season with the TML's longest consecutive winning streak of 12 games (10/7-10/20). The longest losing streak was by Hackensack of 21 straight losses (9/9-10/11). In fact, Hackensack lost 28 of their final 29 games. Sanford put together an 18-1 record from 9/21-10/11, which included games against Beverly, Coachella Valley and Hackensack.

Sanford's Mickey Lolich tied the regular season TML Record for wins (29) and GS (45). As a team, Hackensack set new TML Team Records for fewest SB (9) and most walks allowed (919).

11/8/1971, SB71-CP71, Memorial Stadium
Jim Pertierra's Sanford Browns won their first ever TML American Championship and became the 7th different team to win the Championship in the past 8 seasons! It was the 2nd TML Championship for the franchise. Sioux Falls, having fought Albany to the final day of the season, ran out of gas and fell in 5 games to the Browns. After surging past Cheticamp to win their division, Coopers Pond upset Arkansas to advance to the TML World Series. With the World Series tied at 2 apiece, Sanford came up big to win in 6 games. The unexpected star for the Browns against Coopers Pond was Rudy May (2-0, 0.64). For both playoff series, Don Buford (.413, 19/46, 14 R) and Frank Robinson (.362, 17/47, 16 RBI) led the Sanford offense.

Joe Grzenda (21 SV, 2.68 ERA) was the best pitcher on the team, but he blew 7 out of 28 save opportunities. The batting did a better job of meeting expectations thanks to fine seasons by Willie Crawford (891 OPS, 56 RBI, 294 AB) and Norm Cash (1022 OPS, 31 HR, 109 RBI, 413 AB). Expectations are high for 1970 as both the batting and pitching should improve over their 1971 performance. However, most pundits predict that the Strikers of Rensselaer are stuck in the dreaded mediocrity loop.

$$D = AB + BB + HBP + SH + SF$$

RC / 27 outs: runs created per 27 outs; in other words, the number of runs a player would create if he were to bat in all nine positions in the batting order.

QS (Quality Starts): the number of starts in which a pitcher pitches six (6) innings or more and gives up three (3) runs or fewer.

OAVG: the batting percentage against each pitcher.

Batting & Pitching Leaders: the following symbols were used to denote individual accomplishments that were record-breakers:

◆ - **TML Record**

◇ - **Tied TML Record**

Team Stats: an asterisk (*) preceding any stat indicates that the player or pitcher led his Association in that stat category; a caret (^) indicates that the player or pitcher tied for the lead in his Association in that stat category.
