The expansion drafts were painful for all existing teams. Depth that has been built up over the course(s) of 1 month to 12 years was stripped away in barely an hour in April. The 40 teams made mistakes in protecting and the 8 rookies made mistakes in picking, but guess what, it all worked out.

The sole purpose for the process we used was to make the teams representative. What happened was that the current franchises got a little less good and the new teams remained a cut below. They are competitive, but not world beaters. But, in the context of what the current teams lost, they are pretty well competitive. I know that there has been feelings that expansion did not have to be fair. I respect the opinion, but I do not agree with it. If the expansion was unfair, we would be in trouble within 2 years.

I also recognize, and have had to live for 2 solid years with the Bethlehem situation. I have no clue, and am not about to find out what the motivation was. My fault in the entire matter was that I was slow to pull the trigger on a valued friend. The way the cards played out, Bill is still a friend, but our paths will likely not cross again. Much the same is the way I did not handle the Berkshire situation. Chris' life changed and I could not accept the fact that he was not a teenager anymore. Of course he loved me enough to not want to leave either. Isn't it funny how much trouble you can get in by not talking.

On the other hand, look where communication has gotten us. As Mike pointed out during the course of TML 13, for a League that was rumored to be going belly up in late 1990, the reports of our demise were greatly exaggerated. Certainly not everyone is 100% happy. There is work that needs to be done with the newsletter, but, rest assured, it will be addressed.

So here we are, looking straight at our 20th year just down the road. You have my assurance that we will continue to not be afraid of change. You have my word that we will continue to listen to what you have to say and place great value in your opinions. You have my word that I will go to any length to maintain this League's reputation for leadership and fair play. You have my word that the TML we all will be a part of in 1999 will be every bit as vital and unpredictable as this scrawny teenager of an organization is right now. That is my commitment to you as your Co-Commissioner.

What history took place on the playing field. A new set of track shoes in Kentucky forged new stolen base marks and a careful examination of the steal in the context of the game. Barry Bonds and Frank Thomas dominated the offensive fronts.

Craig Christmann's Spider's closed the loop on a strange elliptic shape for TML Champions from the American. The American Association has won 6 TML Crowns, the National has won 7. But look at this. The 6 American titles have been won by 3 franchises, 2 apiece. Boulder won the first, Toledo the second and Lawrence Molignon the third. The fourth American title was won by Darkfyre, the old Boulder team. The fifth American title was won by Walla Walla, the old Toledo team. The sixth American title was won by Craig's Los Angeles team which, of course, used to be Lawrence Molignon. I love stuff like that.

Who will win it this year? Not New York.

The 48 members of the TML are special people and, although we don't say it officially as much as we should, you are the League and we're happy to be the caretakers.

Let us vow to keep in touch and further vow to always communicate our ideas. There is nothing that will convince me that the greatest idea for the TML has not been spoken yet. Just think how great that will be!

Mike Short's The American Game

When the year 1991 ended, the American Association had three substitute managers, had made several changes during the year, and frankly did not seem strong. By the time the 1992 season ended, the American had 24 managers and a waiting list.

What a difference a year makes.

It was a year which saw the TML Champion emerge from the American. For the first time, Rocky lost in the World Series, defeated by a powerful Los Angeles team, built by Craig Christmann and managed by Gerry Klug in the finals. Rocky normally doesn't lose games, much less a playoff series, but after gaining a two games to one lead, the magic vanished as Gerry refused to take the bait offered by Rocky's pitching changes. Where was Jim Poole by Game 6? Soaking his arm in the ice. And with no one else to turn to, the Wardogs fell. The Spiders, with the best record in the American, completed their season in fine fashion.

But it was not the baseball games that attracted the attention during 1992. It was expansion. After months of debate and discussion, the TML brain trust came up with a scheme designed to make expansion teams that were less than doormats. To hear the hue and cry, one would think maybe they succeeded all too well.

The first round took place in the spring. Each franchise protected 12 players and lost four. Then in September, each franchise protected 16 players (who may or may not have been protected in the Spring) and lost two more. All of this was offset by the magic of the "free" waiver claim, where such notables as Ron Tingley and Junior Ortiz got a second life. The biffing continued, as Colonie, in second place all year, picked after New Jersey, because the posted series to date showed them with a better record. One month later, the system seemed prescient, as Colonie posted their franchise best record, and the second best in the Association.

All summer the debate went on, although the only change to the system was the free waiver claim. The weak teams claimed they were hurt the worst. After all, they had very little they could afford to lose. The good teams complained that they were hurt the most. Of course, they lost more primo players. In the end it was inconclusive. Some weak teams, like Philadelphia, got killed. Some good teams lost great players, like Gary Sheffield and Candy Maldonado, and great prospects like Jose Offerman. The only thing we know

for sure is that we will have no clue how good our opponents will be next year, at least until June.

The second hot topic over the summer was the new draft system. The 1992 season opened with the money dispersal round, an unfortunate addition in an already weak year. The reward for Hank Pedicone, who missed on Mike Mussina by \$2000, was Reggie Sanders. By the time the eighth or ninth pick rolled around, we were down to Joel Johnston and Keith Mitchell, though in retrospect, Rod Beck would have been a good pickup. After that, the money was gone. With more balance in mind, the powers that be combined expansion with a straight (more or less) reverse order of finish draft. The idea was that Mike Mussina and Phil Plantied, at the time considered the two best picks in the 1992 Rookie Draft, should not end up on Colonie and Sherlock, at the time, two of the five best teams in the Association. Time will tell if the new procedure makes any difference, but boy, we hate missing those bonus points.

Without money, waiver claims became problematic. The first idea was to ditch them completely. But the league wanted them, so instead we decided to trade bonus points for claims. All summer, reasonably good people disappeared from the list: Deion Sanders and Cory Snyder got off to hot starts and attracted about 16 claims each. It was this picked-over list that formed the fodder for the "free" waiver claim.

For the first time, all American games were played on computer. While furious battles of diamond dust were taking place out in the American hinterlands, furious development of Diamond Dreams 2.0 was taking place in Albany. Lots of ideas raised by the people playing the games made it into version 2.0. With luck, a lot fewer disappearing baserunners and computer crashes will occur in 1993. (Are crashes the computer equivalent of a rainout?).

The Los Angeles Spiders spun a web few could escape to capture the Ruth Division with the American Association's best record. The Spiders won 109 games to capture the Division by 14 games, after tying with Sherlock last year. Los Angeles is the only American team to win 100 games both 1991 and 1992, and join Sherlock and Colonie as the only teams to win 100 games twice in the '90's.

While the Spider pitching staff was outstanding, Los Angeles mainly battered their opponents into submission, sporting several notable performances. Ca. Ripken combined Gold Glove defense with 45 2Bs, 33

HRs and 125 RBIs to gain definite MVP consideration. Hal Morris barely qualified for the Batting Title, but put together enough plate appearances for his .354 average to lead the Association, and drove in 104 runs in the process. Tim Raines and Wade Boggs spent the year running around the bases, 122 and 94 times respectively, partly due to Raines' 54 stolen bases and Boggs' 53 doubles. Taken together, the Spiders scored 864 times to lead the Association. The pitching staff featured three 20 game winners, Rijo (21-3, 2.48), Appier (23-7, 2.84) and Morris (20-12, 3.48). Aguilera (0.57) nailed down 30 saves in only 36 appearances.

Los Angeles defeated Pensacola to win the Western Conference Championship, and disposed of New Jersey for the right to play Kentucky for all the marbles.

The Colonie Flames ignited when it counted, sending ball after ball out of the park down the stretch to overtake New Jersey and win the Gehrig Division by nine games. The Pinstripers had led most of the way, for the last time by a game after series 10, but struggled down the stretch as Colonie put it all together. With 106 wins, the 1992 Colonie Flames set a franchise record for excellence, breaking the old record of 105 set in 1987. By striking out 1108 opponents, the Flames extended their League whiff record to seven consecutive years with 1000 or more strikeouts. Also falling in 1992 were the franchise records for home runs (211), runs (822), and fewest home runs allowed (89). Basically, the Flame philosophy was hit the ball out and be sure the other guy doesn't, as they led the Association in both offensive homers and fewest allowed. Once Kevin Mitchell returned from the DL about Summer Stretch time, the Flames shifted into gear, playing over .700 ball for the second half of the season. Mitchell led the team in HRs (34) and RBIs (105) despite batting only 371 times. Terry Pendleton scored 122 runs with 72 extra base hits. Eight Flames hit ten or more home runs, and five hit 20 or more (with Baines falling just short at 18). Tom Candiotti went 20-8 and the bullpen won 30 games as the Flames led the Association in relief points for the sixth year out of the last seven.

The Pensacola Stingrays repeated as Robinson Division winners with a 90-70 record. The Rays were the only team in the division above .500.

Good offensive production from the Ding-a-Lings (Jay Bell and Albert Belle) paced Pensacola to a comfortable lead over Oh Zee and Skayuna. Bell score 94 times based on 64 extra base hits, and Belle led the

team with 32 HRs and 87 RBIs, though limited to 499 at bats by a variety of suspensions and arguments with Manager Mark Hetterich. On the mound, Trevor Wilson excelled (16-6, 2.98) while the one-two punch of Lee Smith and Rob Dibble (25 and 16 saves respectively) closed out many games.

Pensacola defeated Sherlock for a shot at the Western Conference Championship, but fell to Los Angeles.

The Rockford Radar fought off furious challenges from Cheticamp and Walla Walla to win the Williams Division by a scant two games. Rockford's 85-75 record is a tribute to the balance in the division, where the three way dogfight went down to the final weekend of the season. Barry Bonds and John Kruk provided the fireworks, Bonds scored 111 times, while driving in 94 with 25 HRs. Kruk led the team with 28 homers and 110 RBIs. Rockford was actually out-scored by its opponents, as they sport an ERA almost half a run higher than their nearest playoff opponent. Regardless, four starters won at least 13 games, and Mitch "Wild Thang" Williams nailed down 36 games with saves. (He also walked 5.7 men per nine innings).

Rockford hosted New Jersey for the opportunity to play Colonie, but fell to the Pinstripers in a hard-fought series.

New Jersey (97-63) and Sherlock (95-65) may have sported the third and fourth best records in the American, but they had the misfortune to play in division where opponents won more than one hundred times. Both the Pinstripers and the C's were rewarded with wild card berths.

New Jersey sported a heavily platooned offense which took advantage of every weakness in the other team. Despite hitting only 130 home runs, New Jersey scored 774 runs. Stingy pitching and defense completed the picture. New Jersey beat Rockford, then squelched the Colonie offense to make it to the championship round.

Sherlock was similar to Colonie, with a little less power, a little less pitching and a lot more speed. The C's sent out 188 home runs, while allowing only 115, and sprinted to 289 doubles, second among playoff teams only to LA with 315.

No one knows what 1993 will bring, with expansion spreading players all over. For once, we will truly have to play the season to find the best teams. See you then.
