# California & Chesapeake Win Big! Glenmont Stays Strong!

In the Atmospheric Conference, the California Black Sox (a league-tying best 25-7 in the Stretch) regained first place over the Chesapeake Steaming Crabs (23-9) in the Pertierra Division, but are separated by only 1 game. This race will likely come down to the wire! In the Robinson, the Glenmont Haymakers (25-7 in the Stretch) now have a 10-game lead over Vanderlyle (21-11) and are the front runner for Conference best record! In the Gatto, Santa Ana still leads by only 1 game over New York (both 18-14), with Beverly (19-13) now only 3 games off the pace! The new ERA leader is 'Skayuna's Tanner Houck at 1.77, followed by Arkansas's Ronel Blanco (1.83) and Glenmont's Framber Valdez (1.88). The new victories leader is Santa Ana's Max Fried (15-4). There are four others with 14 wins and 5 others with 13. The new Strikeout leader is Albany's Garrett Crochet with 196 K. The new Saves leader is Glenmont's Ryan Helsley (33/35 SVO in 45 GR, 1.07 ERA).
