In the Atmospheric Conference, the Gatto Division came down to the wire as New York (11-5 in the month) fell short by only 2 games behind Santa Ana (9-7). There were two 20-game winners, Wheeler (20-7) and Kentucky's Logan Webb (20-10). The Strikeout champ is Madison's Logan Gilbert with 250 K. The "Fireman of the Year" is Rocky Mountain's Mason Miller (45 RP, 42/43 SVO in 55 GR, 0.94).
