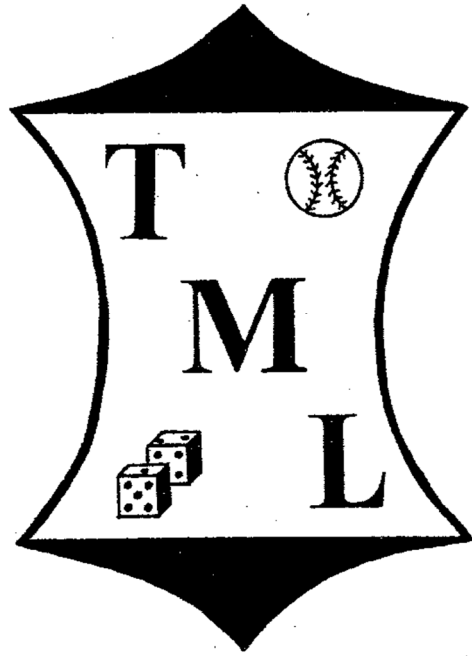

All time single season TML Records were set by **Lou Gehrig** in AVG (.457), Hits (290), Runs (220), TB (514) and RC (294) and by **Babe Ruth** in BB (195) and OBP (.557). **Earle Combs** tied the record for 3B (33). Single season team TML Records were set by **Albany** in AVG (.350), SLG (.582), Runs (1473), Hits (2072), 2B (418), RBI (1428), BB (882) and ABs (5913),

The longest winning streak of 19 games was done by **Albany** (5/18-6/8). The longest losing streak of 14 games was by **Bronx** (8/10-8/26).

11/3/1930, AV30-NA30, Forbes Field  
 Pat Barry's record setting **Albany Avalanche** captured a record 15<sup>th</sup> TML Championship! For Manager Barry, it is his TML leading 14<sup>th</sup> TML Championship! They cruised through the post season, dispatching Mike Dickinson's Beverly Hillbillies in the Conference Final and Mike Ameen's North Adams Bevers in the TML World Series, both in 5 games. North Adams had advanced to the World Series by defeating Eric Rogers's Chestertown Blue Herons in 5 games. Albany's Playoff MVP **Lou Gehrig** completed his record-setting season by hitting .550 (22/40), with 17 runs, 15 RBI, 4 2Bs, 2 3B, 3 HRs and 11 BB in the 10 post season games!

The Hillbillies had an outstanding season, finishing second in a loaded Oceanic Division, but met their expected fate against the Avalanche in the playoffs. The season was driven by offense. Al Simmons was spectacular, hitting .406 with 47 home runs and 102 extra-base hits. Chuck Klein added a .390 average with 97 extra-base hits, including 30 home runs. Mel Ott showed limited power but posted a remarkable .501 OBP, fueled by 153 walks. The offense buoyed a mediocre pitching staff (5.00 team ERA, 8th in the 14-team league). Guy Bush led the staff with 23 wins despite a 5.37 ERA, while George Earnshaw, Phil Collins, and Syl Johnson recorded 19, 17, and 16 wins, respectively. Collins and Johnson were the only pitchers with ERAs under 4.00. The Hillbillies likely have a couple more years to contend before a major rebuilding effort becomes necessary.

Even though it seemed like the typical 50-50 shot at nailing down a save (my estimate of the save rate for a bad bullpen) with blown leads, Tommy Thomas managed to survive with 25 of 31 leads to be least-incendiary-relief-pitcher of the year. The offense remained bad, only outscoring the worst offense by 7 runs, as the lack of power led to an unsuccessful hit-'em-where-they-ain't year. Still, the recent voyage to the bottom of the standings allowed the debut of Harry Heilmann (54 doubles, 90 rbi). The drive towards consistent mediocrity will hopefully keep Bloomington from suffering its own stock market crash in 1929.

## *The Season Story*

The 1930 Walla Walla Wombats endured a brutal 36–118 season, finishing with the league’s worst record. The lineup featured several standout performers, led by Charlie Gehringer, who hit .322 with 18 home runs, 147 runs, and 87 RBI, anchoring the middle of the order. Paul Waner added a strong .328 average with 194 hits, 105 runs, and 93 RBI, while Ray Blades was electric in limited action, batting .439 with a 1.260 OPS. Dusty Cooke also impressed, hitting .330 with power and patience, and Johnny Gooch contributed 99 RBI behind the plate. However, pitching completely unraveled the season. The staff posted a 7.51 ERA, allowing 1,324 runs with opponents hitting .332. Snipe Hansen (5–24) and Lou McEvoy (5–31) logged heavy innings but were consistently hit hard, while Doug McWeeny and Roy Parmelee struggled with control and run prevention. Even veteran Grover Alexander faltered with a 10.25 ERA. Despite a capable offense, the Wombats’ inability to stop opponents proved overwhelming, leaving them at the bottom of the standings and in clear need of a complete pitching overhaul.
